THIS SUNDAY'S READINGS

1st Reading

He has not commanded anyone to be ungodly.

2nd Reading

A wisdom God decreed before the ages for our glory.

Gospel

.It was said to those of old; but I say to you.

If you were there at the time of Jesus, what impression would you have of him? What would you think of him and his *modus operandi*?

Would you think of him as a breath of fresh air or a law breaker who is only but confusing the people?

Before your honest response, put yourself in the context of the people of Jesus' time. Would you be any different from the Scribes and the Pharisees?

The people got agitated about this new man in town with new teaching. Is he going to throw all we have been taught in the Scripture and Tradition in the thrash? What's he going to do or say next? It was not just a mere reflection. It was a mindful storm among the people.

It is in this context that Jesus declares his mission and intention: I have come, not to abolish the Law but to fulfil it. This is the core message of Matthew's account.

It is easier to look back in hindsight, on behalf of the people of Old, and see what they couldn't see. But often, God's wisdom is not found in hindsight or foresight, but insight. The Spirit has always revealed the wisdom of God and his plan. The one who oversees the entire creation (Sirach 15:15-20) has perfectly ordered all things in Christ.
