THIS SUNDAY'S READINGS

1st Reading

Your light shall break forth like the dawn.

2nd Reading

I proclaimed to you the mystery of Christ crucified.

Gospel

You are the light of the world.

Following Last Sunday's sermon on the mount, this Sunday's readings from Isaiah 58:7-10, Psalm 111/112, 1Cor 2:1-5 and Matthew 5:13-15 speak of Justice and Light as redemptive elements for humanity. If you are just and true, your light will shine.

In the sermon on the mount, Matthew 5:1-12, the Lord identifies our true happiness in what happens to us and who we are (subjective), while in the context of verses 13-16, it is about what we do to others (objective). It is not enough to be good; we need to do good. Passive life of forbearance, gentleness, and kindness may not be enough, sometimes. We need to engage also in acts of justice.

You are the light of the world and the salt of the land. Sunlight shines from above the earth, while salt is below the earth. Shine as bright and as far as possible, while being grounded in humility and acts of justice.

Salt has four outstanding material and spiritual (sacramental) elements: Purity, Healing, Preservative, and Taste.

Go out to the whole world and light up the nations; purify, heal, safeguard the vulnerable, and add taste to the world where so many are losing the taste of true Faith, Hope and Love.
